

# Diploma of Biblical Theology (DBT)

## Course Overview

### Structure and Duration

There are eight units of study: three core units and five electives, in the areas of Biblical Studies, Christian Thought and Ministry. Our core units are at a higher level of study than the electives.

The course is available in both full-time and part-time delivery mode. Full-time study is for 1 year whereas part-time can be completed doing 1 or a couple of units at a time, over a maximum duration of 6 years.

### Tuition Fees

Core units are AUD\$1,130 and elective units are AUD\$920 bringing the total cost to \$7990 in 2023.

Australian citizens may be eligible for FEE-HELP which is an Australian Government loan scheme for tuition fees. International students are welcome to apply for a scholarship for this course; for more information please see <https://moore.edu.au/scholarship-awards/>

### Level of Study and Demand

The level of study is that of higher education. Each unit has 96 demand hours over the semester (13 weeks approximately with some breaks and research weeks) so students would be looking at a commitment of approximately 6-7 hours of study per week for each unit. There are regular quizzes and forums requiring weekly involvement with the course and students will work towards a final essay with tutor and peer feedback along the way. This course is designed to be as interactive as possible. Online learning tools allow students to participate in virtual classrooms and dedicated tutors coach students through their assessment tasks.

If you wish to apply, you can do so through our online application form at <https://moore.edu.au/apply/> The admission requirements include at minimum an Australian higher school certificate (or equivalent qualification). Domestic mature age students may qualify by an entrance exam instead. Students whose language of study was not in English will need to provide IELTS results, receiving at least a score of 6.5 in each section.

During the application process you will need to upload a form of identification (such as birth certificate), academic transcripts and residency documents (if applicable). You will also need to provide the name and email of your senior minister as a referee. After we have received your application, all documents and the reference, your application will be reviewed and then we will be in contact via email with a letter of outcome.
